Wednesday 5th

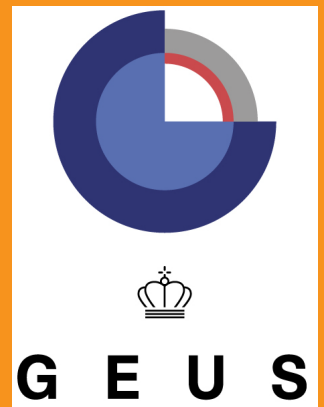
- 9.00-16.00 Presentations incl. coffee breaks and lunch (included in registration fee)
